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### 1. IDENTIFICATION OF THE SUBSTANCE / PREPARATION AND OF THE COMPANY / UNDERTAKING

**Product name:** AIR FRESHENER TROPICAL

**Synonyms:** DETERGENT SANITISER

**Use / description of product:** Liquid. No significant hazard. The regulatory information is dependent upon the concentration limit of the specific substance.

### 2. COMPOSITION / INFORMATION ON INGREDIENTS

**Ingredient 1:** CATIONIC SURFACTANT (R047) <10%

**Ingredient 2:** DIETHYLENE GLYCOL <10%

[Xn] R22;

**Ingredient 3:** NON IONIC SURFACTANT (R044) <10%

[Xn] R22; [Xi] R36/38; [N] R53;

### 3. HAZARDS IDENTIFICATION

**Main hazards:** No significant hazard.

### 4. FIRST AID MEASURES (SYMPTOMS)

**Skin contact:** There may be mild irritation at the site of contact.

**Eye contact:** There may be irritation and redness.

**Ingestion:** There may be irritation of the throat. There may be vomiting.

**Inhalation:** There may be vomiting.

### 4. FIRST AID MEASURES (ACTION)

**Skin contact:** Remove all contaminated clothes and footwear immediately unless stuck to skin. Drench the affected skin with running water for 10 minutes or longer if substance is still on skin. Transfer to hospital if there are burns or symptoms of poisoning.

**Eye contact:** Bathe the eye with running water for 15 minutes. Transfer to hospital for specialist examination.

**Ingestion:** Do not induce vomiting. If conscious, give 1 pint of water to drink immediately. If unconscious, check for breathing and apply artificial respiration if necessary. If unconscious and breathing is OK, place in the recovery position. Transfer to hospital as soon as possible.

**Inhalation:** Remove casualty from exposure ensuring one's own safety whilst doing so. If

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unconscious, check for breathing and apply artificial respiration if necessary. If unconscious and breathing is OK, place in the recovery position. If conscious, ensure the casualty sits or lies down. If breathing becomes bubbly, have the casualty sit and provide oxygen if available. Transfer to hospital as soon as possible.

**5. FIRE-FIGHTING MEASURES**

**Extinguishing media:** Carbon dioxide.

**Protection of fire-fighters:** Wear protective clothing to prevent contact with skin and eyes.

**6. ACCIDENTAL RELEASE MEASURES**

**Personal precautions:** Refer to section 8 of SDS for personal protection details.

**Environmental precautions:** Contain the spillage using bunding.

**Clean-up procedures:** Wash the spillage site with large amounts of water.

**7. HANDLING AND STORAGE**

**Handling requirements:** Do not handle in a confined space.

**Storage conditions:** Store in cool, well ventilated area. Keep container tightly closed.

**Engineering measures:** Ensure there is sufficient ventilation of the area.

**Respiratory protection:** Self-contained breathing apparatus must be available in case of emergency.

**Hand protection:** Protective gloves.
